**INTRODUCTION:**

The Florida International Leadership Conference (FILC) is dedicated to providing a unique leadership training experience and networking opportunities for student leaders with international education experiences.

**GOALS of CONFERENCE:**

- To improve the leadership abilities of international and U.S. study abroad students
- To facilitate a cross cultural exchange of ideas and to foster international relationships
- To challenge students to see themselves as global leaders
- To enable students to take back what they learn and apply it to their campuses
- To acknowledge student leaders who promote international understanding on campus.

**CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS:** We seek session proposals in four areas.

- **Campus Leadership:** Proposals in this category would include sessions on innovative ideas for student organization programming, models for creating and/or expanding an organization, ideas on collaborations with campus or community organizations, officer development, advocacy, ways students can make a difference, etc.
- **Leadership, General:** Proposals in this category would include sessions on leadership development, models, theories, and studies of leadership, leadership and career preparation, leadership opportunities, etc.
- **Cross-cultural Enrichment:** Proposals in this category would include sessions on reentry, culture shock and adjustment, cross-cultural training, cross-cultural simulations, orientations, etc.
- **Cultural Expressions:** Proposals in this category would include interactive and educational sessions on food, language, dance, entertainment, meditation, games, etc.

Presentations should be prepared for 60-75 minute presentation time. To submit proposals, please complete the application form by **Friday, January 8, 2010**. If you have any questions, please contact Brent Turner – [bturner@rollins.edu](mailto:bturner@rollins.edu).

If your proposal is accepted, you will need to register for the conference. There is a registration form for advisors, faculty, staff, community members, and *presenters*.
